R = ring Ch = chain - = picot

-- = progressively larger/smaller picot + = join RW = reverse work DNRW = do not reverse work

> 2 buttons of similar size, 4 holes Sample made with ½ inch buttons

R1 3+3 to one hole of the top button DNRW

R2 5+5 to one hole of the bottom button RW

Ch 4 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 4 RW

R3 5+5 to same hole as R2 RW

Ch 4 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 4 RW

R4 5+5 to next hole of the bottom button RW

Ch 4 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 4 RW

R5 5+5 to same hole as R4 RW

R10 3+3 to next hole of the top button RW Ch 4 RW

R11 3+3 to same hole as R10 RW

Ch 3 - 2 - 2 - 3 RW

R12 3+3 to next hole of the top button RW

Ch 3 - 2 - 2 - 3 RW

R13 3+3 to same hole as R12 RW

Ch 3 - 2 - 2 - 3 RW

R14 3+3 to next hole of the top button RW

Ch 3 - 2 - 2 - 3 RW

R15 3+3 to same hole as R14 RW

Ch 3 - 2 - 2 - 3 RW

R16 3+3 to same hole as R1 RW

Ch 4

Join to base of R1.

Cut the hat out of felt and the scarf out of ribbon and glue to snowman. Glue a tatted flower to the hat. Looks good on a barrette or a pin back.
