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Introduction

This is a simple game that I have created for the family to enjoy some quality bonding time. It is also a great game to help children learn and familiarize themselves with spelling of simple words while fishing. I will also be incorporating this game into my anger management exercise with my 3 kids, as any competitions would easily induce challenges and frustrations in children, and this could be an exercise you could consider for that purpose.

The template enclosed is a set of alphabets created on the very colourful fishes. Enclosed are some simple instructions of how you could make use of the template.

You would need:

- 1 pair of scissors
- 52 paper clips
- Some magnets (Depending on how many players)
- Some long sticks (Depending on how many players)
- Strings

Simple Instructions:

Step 1: Make two printout copies of the fish template.

Step 2: Cut out the fishes from the printout, you should have two full sets of alphabets from A to Z. (4 sets of E and S).

Step 3: Attach paper clips to each of the fish

Step 4: Tie strings to the magnets you have prepared.

Step 5: Attach the other end of the string to the sticks you have prepared.

Step 6: Spread the fishes randomly on a table or floor.

(You may even want to laminate the fishes printout to water proof them and place them into a small tub of water for more fun.)

Step 7: Start Fishing!!

You can create a list of words prior to the game, or the players can think of words randomly. If you require lengthy words that exceed 2 repeated alphabets, you may need to make more copies of the fish template.
