### Six-Week Mission:

#### Week 1: Walks

**Playing** out and about with friends on a walk.

**Looking** for the perfect secret spot for later without your friends seeing.

**Making** a plan to return to the spot to hide some treasure.

*Curator's Tip: you could take some photos to help you make your map later.*



#### Week 2: Pick the Treasure

**Playing** with your stuff at home.

**Looking** for items in your collection that you're happy for your friends to find.

**Making** a container to keep your treasure in that will withstand weather.

*Curator's Tip: Decorating your treasure box will help to make it look grand and precious.*



#### Week 3: Preparing for the Grand Hunt

**Playing** outside to find the perfect route for the walk.

**Looking** for the best place to put the treasure.

**Making** a map of the route for a friend to follow with clues and obstacles.

*Curator's Tip: Make a photocopy of your map and keep it in your treasure zone.*

## Week 4: Map Swap

**Playing** with your friends, looking at each other's maps and talking about the routes.

**Looking** at the reactions your friends have to the map, take photos.

**Making** a sheet with your predictions for the day, this could be in the form of cartoons.

*Curator's Tip: Don't take it too seriously; it's supposed to be fun!*

## Week 5: The Grand Treasure Hunt

Set up a treasure hunt day at the weekend with friends or family members. It could be in the garden, inside or even on the street itself **if it's safe**.

You could also have an audience and create a programme for the day.

*Curator's Tip: Take photos on the day to preserve the event.*



## Week 6: Caboodle It!

**Make** a Caboodle biog of your adventures, maps and any other images including descriptions.

*Caboodler's Tip: You need at least five photos to publish your pictures with short descriptions on Caboodle.org.uk*

**Museum Mission: Go to a museum that contains maps. You could also go to a visitor's garden. If you have permission take photographs of what you find and include at least three cool facts for Caboodle.**
