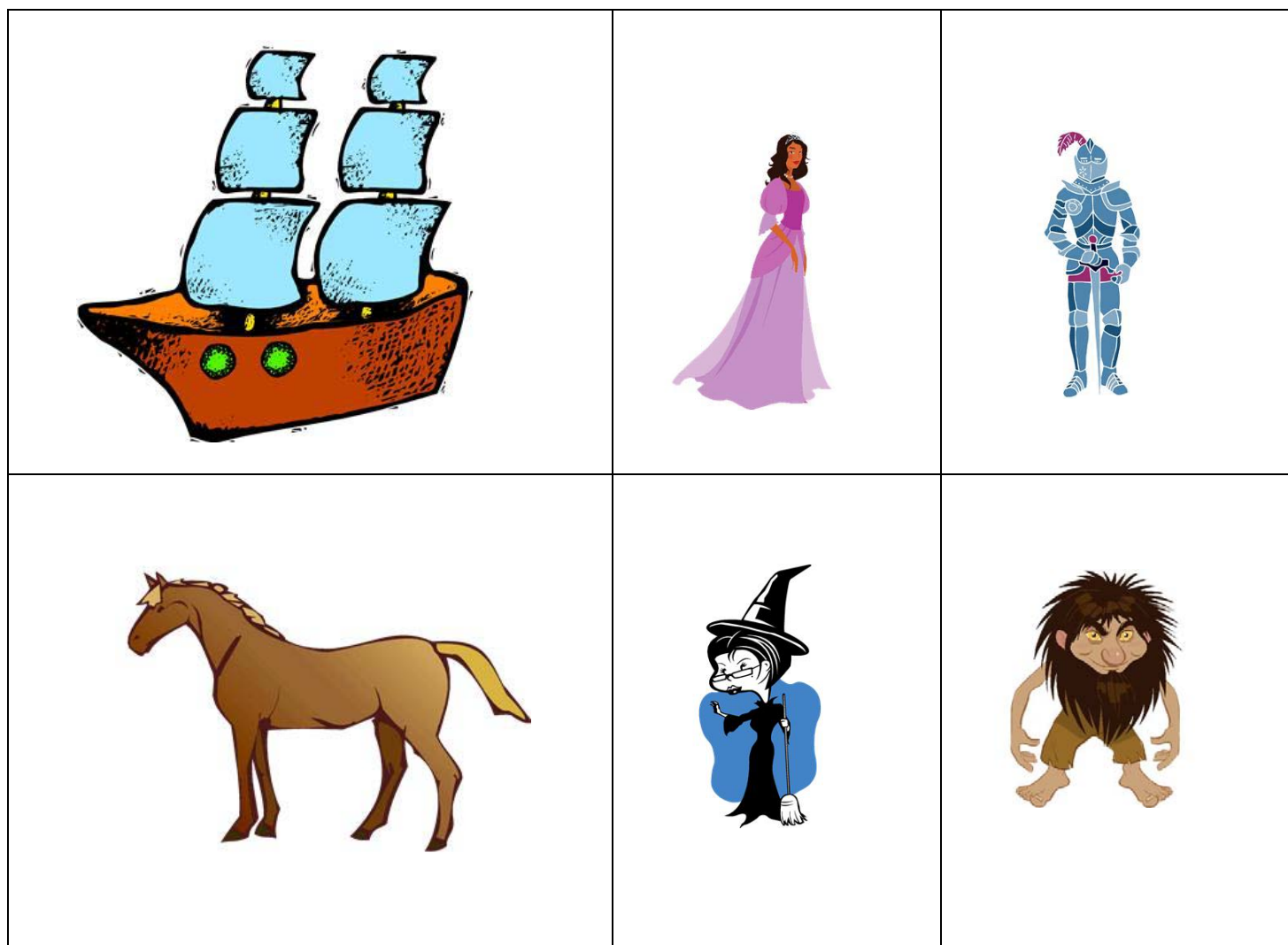


## Story Board Helpers

Your students can use these pictures to tell a story. I had some old refrigerator magnets which I cut up into strips. I put magnetic strips on the back of the figures so they will stick to a white board. If you use a white board, you can add more details by drawing in back ground objects with markers.

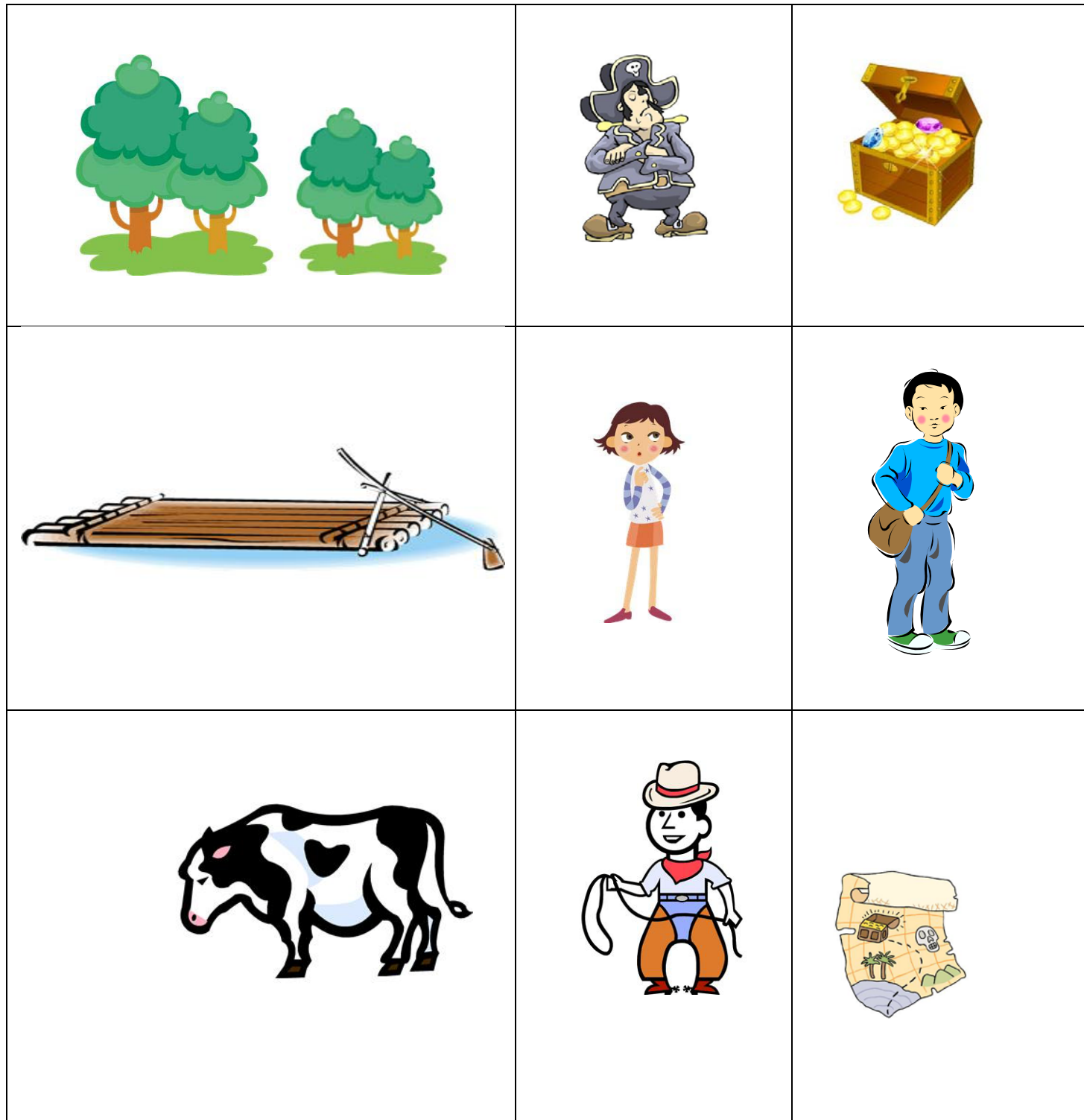
