.... Not much!

- All transportation to the lodge and trails is provided at no charge by volunteer EAA members. All parking, cooking, organizing, set-up, bathroom clean-up, water, ice, lighting, electrical hook-ups, etc. are provided by EAA volunteers who just like to talk and live airplanes. All of the firewood is cut and toted by your RV EAA buddies from Hot Springs and we burned a bunch last year.
- We have a great campground, and great aircraft parking but that isn't quite free.
 We do have to have the taxiway and additional parking mowed and filled, campsites maintained etc., trees cleared, and typical upkeep. If you're having a good time, we would ask that you donate about \$10 a night per plane if you are lodging and \$15 a night if you are camping. This covers the State Park Campsite Fees, ramp use, firewood, electricity, showers, restrooms, etc.
- All meals are provided by EAA local chapters KHOT and KORK and pretty much served at cost. Think about donations of \$6 for breakfast and lunch and \$8 for dinner. I promise you will love it! Double your money back guarantee ©
