

Teddy Bear Snake and Ladder Race

The little bears went into the forest to pick some apples for grandmother bear. As they were finished with basket full of apples and making their way back, they ran into obstacles and challenges. Hope kids will find this little game fun and educational.

Suggested game play instructions:

- 1 Get the children to pick a bear each.
- 2 Fold the bottom along the dotted line to form a stand.
- 3 Place all the numbered apples into a bag/box, and the addition, subtraction, division and multiply sign in another box.
- 4 Get the children to pick a number each, the child with the smallest number starts first.
- 5 Place all the numbers back into the bag/box once they are picked and used.
- 6 To proceed, each child picks two numbers and a sign, and are required to answer the math correctly.
- 7 The child then gets to move the number of steps that the math number works out.
- 8 If a child fails to answer the math correctly, he misses a turn.

Example:

If the child picks an 8, 5 and "-".

He needs to work out 8-5.


If he answers correctly, he gets to move 3 steps forward.


