

Quiz - Use your map to mark the following locations. Be sure to answer the questions asked below.

1. The following entry is from the log of Captain James Kirk: "Shiver me timbers, I've lost me gold filling from me tooth, but I cannot stay to look for it. I'll be back next season to find it! Me Greenwich chronometer says 2 AM but the time here is 1:12 PM and I can see the pole star at 34 and one half degrees above the horizon." Find this location and mark it with an F for "filling lost here".
2. Captain Plumo Avarian has just placed the following entry in his log: "It is a sad day when I must lay to rest me most trusted mate. I will never forget how she nibbled on my ear and cracked nuts for me. I can see Snake Rock at a bearing of 57° and the Lone Palm is at a bearing of S 50° E". Mark the location where the Captain buried his parrot with a P .
3. In the log of Captain Fligh is written: "Ar Ar Ar! I have sunk that blasted British ship, and someday I will return and salvage her cannons. She is sunk at the following location: bearing to the tip of Great Cornu Pt. is 101° and I can barely see Pico Atoll at a bearing of S 6° E." Mark the location of Captain Fligh and the sunken ship with an S .
4. Captain Indy Fogg has been searching for vagabond vessels to pirate. He is anchored where he can see Pico Atoll at a bearing of 241° and the pole star at 35° and 30' above the horizon. Mark the location of Captain Fogg with an I .
