Dear Dr. Reimann,

RE: a project vital for civilization

I am an independent researcher, PhD, an Israeli citizen, currently a pensioner, 80. I apply to you concerning a project vital for the destiny of civilization, for the destiny of Europe, in particular. The project is based on my decades-long independent research in exact sciences and humanities, that I providentially started 45 years ago in Russia and since 1992 have proceeded with in Israel, Europe and Canada. That research, due to its radically new method, enabled me to achieve the following:

- (1) to reform modern theoretical physics;
- (2) to discover the true philosophy of science: the true systems theory;
- (3) to create the frameworks of the true sciences of politics and economics;
- (4) to work out a methodology for reforming modern science in general.

The essence of my project is as follows. Civilization has been experiencing a general ideological crisis now threatening the very existence of humankind. Underlying that crisis is the crisis of modern science, philosophy and religion – the three spheres of human intellectual activity responsible for the ideology of modern society. Thus, to resolve the above general crisis, it is necessary to reform the above three spheres. I have started such a reform, launched a dedicated website and achieved significant results, but such a historic mission cannot hinge long on the enthusiasm of a pensioner - it needs a wide international support.

At present I have been seeking an opportunity to establish an NGO, possibly in Switzerland, titled perhaps THE WORLD REFORM CENTER (WRC), committed to the above mission. The main tasks of the WRC would be as follows:

- (1) attracting highly professional researchers and philosophers worldwide to start reforming science in their field of interest, creating first frameworks of the new sciences and then developing them into textbooks and online courses for universities; my enclosed works being used for guidance and as examples; at present I expect great results in reforming biology and microbiology, in particular;
- (2) attracting philosophers of religion to create the science of religion suitable for universities;
- (3) raising a fund to run the Center, attract scientists, stimulate their work and reward their success;

I expect enthusiastic donations from organizations and private persons.

Participation of the university in that project would be absolutely necessary, because it could provide the professional expertise of my works, be the first university to start implementing the project and provide authoritative opinion of it for philanthropist organizations and scientific funds to sponsor it. I would like to run the project for two years at least and prepare young researchers to substitute me when necessary. I could also read lectures on the new physics, the science of politics and the philosophy of science for postgraduate students.

I have just arrived in Zurich with very limited resources but determined to start that project despite many obstacles. In this connection would you please make an appointment for me to Prof. Dr. Michael Hengartner, President of the Executive Board, to consider the project and discuss its details.
