Dear Sir (Madam),

RE: item 17812 non-delivery

As you remember, we have an agreement on delivering my item 17812 (my old laptop computer) lost 14.11.15 and later found at the CDG-1 airport. On 24.11.2015, you took 150 euro from my account for the delivery. You promised to send me the tracking number but failed. Then the delivery was intercepted by the shipping company UPS, controlled in Israel, to my knowledge, by Russian agents – my enemies. Instead of delivering my item to me, they started demanding some custom duty payment on false pretense and with false invoice bill. When I informed them of their mistake, they refused to recognize their fault and not delivered my item to me yet. So their true purpose seems to steal my computer and take valuable scientific information from it, a blunt pirate action, an organized international crime.

In this connection would you please apply to the HQs of the UPS, an allegedly international organization, send them copy of the documents concerning our agreement, attached here, and demand immediate delivery of my item to me. Its UPS reference number: 1ZV198V60498357324. If necessary, please apply also to the international arbitrage. I attach here four documents, of BDM and UPS.
