1. DISCONNECT CABLE FROM NEGATIVE BATTERY TERMINAL

CAUTION:


Wait at least 90 seconds after disconnecting the cable from the negative (-) battery terminal to disable the SRS system.

NOTICE:

- · After turning the ignition switch off, waiting time may be required before disconnecting the cable from the battery terminal. Therefore, make sure to read the disconnecting the cable from the battery terminal notice before proceeding with work (Click here)
- When disconnecting the cable, some systems need to be initialized after the cable is reconnected (Click here).


2. REMOVE FRONT DOOR LOWER FRAME BRACKET GARNISH LH

3. REMOVE NO. 2 DOOR INSIDE HANDLE BEZEL LH



- b. Detach the 2 clamps, move the wire harness out of the way and remove the service hole cover.



18. REMOVE FRONT DOOR GLASS SUB-ASSEMBLY LH


- a. Connect the cable to the negative (-) battery terminal.
- **b.** Connect the power window regulator master switch assembly and move the front door glass subassembly so that the door glass bolts can be seen.
- Disconnect the cable from the negative (-) battery terminal and power window regulator master switch assembly.

CAUTION:

Do not place your finger, etc. within the range of movement of the window regulator. When removing the power window regulator motor, the force of the spring causes the window regulator to move in the direction of the arrow shown in the illustration (the direction in which the window rises), which may cause injury. NOTICE: Be careful when removing the screws as the motor may fall and become damaged.




