Dear Mr. Netanyahu:

RE: mission vital for civilization in a concentration camp

I am an Israeli citizen, 81; a scientist with a degree “Candidate of Science in Technology” (1965).
My 40-year-long independent research is priceless; it is a turning point in the history of civilization.
Despite my age, I proceed with my unique mission which is vital for the destiny of civilization, the Jewish people, in particular.

For almost ten years I have lived in a social hostel that is beyond the normal Israeli jurisdiction.

The hostel is controlled by Russian agents, the same sort of people who persecuted me in Russia.
After my immigration in Israel in 1992, those people started an omnipresent secret war against me.

This May my hostel rent was not taken from my account, which is perhaps a warning of the forthcoming deprivation of the housing. So the above Russian agents now intend either to evict me in the street or perhaps even to deport me to Russia. All that looks like an attempt on my life.

In this connection would you please take urgent measures to provide me with the normal living conditions in Israel. Please see online papers enclosed.
