
The National Park Service operates the LBJ Ranch and offers public access to the ranch, Texas Whitehouse, LBJ's birthplace, . Johnson family cemetery, old Junction School, LBJ's grandparents' home and ranch showbarn. For a free ranch driving permit, visit the LBJ State Park Visitor Center between 9AM and 4:30PM Guided NPS ranger tours of LBJ's office and home are offered from 10AM to 4:30PM for \$3.

Located in Johnson City, this National Historical Park offers a Visitor Center with exhibits and films on LBJ and Lady Bird, the Boyhood Home, an education building and the historic Johnson Settlement.

Hours: Visitor Center and Boyhood Home 9AM to 5PM daily; Johnson Settlement 9AM to sunset daily; No admission fee at Johnson City District.



Listed in the National Register of Historic Places, the district has more than 80 points of historic interest and significance in the district. Stroll past many of Fredericksburg's famous structures and see the pride taken in both homes and businesses by the local residents. Free self-guided walking tour maps of the district are available at the main Visitor Information Center at 302 East Austin Street in downtown Fredericksburg.
