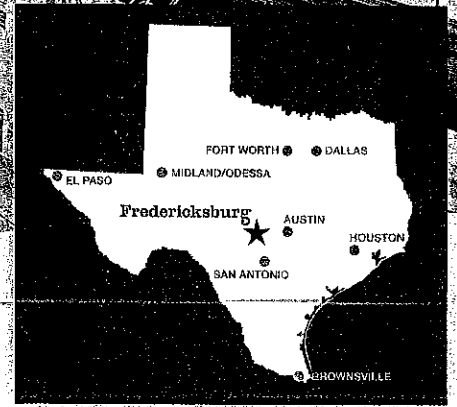


Top 10 reasons to plan your next meeting or conference in Fredericksburg

NATIONAL HISTORIC DISTRICT HEART OF FREDERICKSBURG

Listed in the National Register of Historic Places, the district has more than 80 points of historic interest and significance in the district. Stroll past many of Fredericksburg's famous structures and see the pride taken in both homes and businesses by the local residents. Free self-guided walking tour maps of the district are available at the main Visitor Information Center at 302 East Austin Street in downtown Fredericksburg.

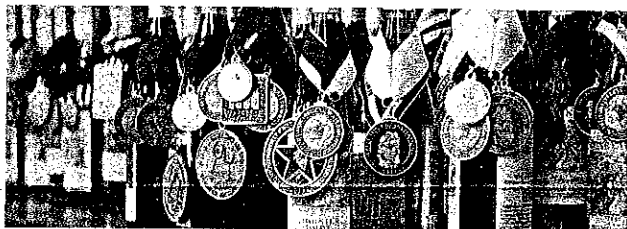
