# **Honey Comb Charm**

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I wish I was at Palmetto's 2019....

Each motif needs 1.5 yards on shuttle and 1 yard for ball thread  $\mathbf{1}^{\text{st}}$  **Motif** 

**R1** 3 - 3 - 3

**R2** 3 - 3 - 3

C1 3 - 3 - 3

\*R 3 + (p on prev ring) 3 - 3

**R** 3 - 3 - 3\*

C 3 + (p on prev chain) 3 - 3\*

Repeat from \* to \* around motif

On the last picot, join to the first picot on the first chain.

Cut and hide ends

## 2<sup>nd</sup> Motif

**R1**  $3-3 + (picot R1 on 1^{st} motif) 3$ 

**R2**  $3 - 3 + (picot R2 on 1^{st} motif) 3$ 

C1 3 - 3 - 3

\*R  $3 + (p \text{ on prev ring}) 3 + (picot R3 \text{ on } 1^{st} \text{ motif}) 3$ 

**R**  $3 + (1^{st} \text{ picot R4 on } 1^{st} \text{ motif}) 3 - 3$ 

C 3 + (p on prev chain) 3 - 3\*


Repeat from \* to \* around, each time matching the joins to the next set of rings.

Before joining the last rings slip in hexagon

On the last picot join to the first picot on the first chain.

End the round joining back to C1 on 2<sup>nd</sup> motif

### Honey Comb Charm



Make 2 motifs. When Making the 2nd motif join all the outside picot to the 1st motif.

Slide in the woody peice before joining the last picots.

#### Then:

Chain 30- 40 double stitches to create a hanger or loop to attach to something. Then join to C1 on the first motif. Hide ends

#### Then

Make a tassel through the picot on the bottom.

C- Chain

5 yards thread Shuttle or needle Hexagon woody or ice drop gem Crochet hook
