

Scientific strategy towards Russia

An overview of some central international events nowadays suggests that the main reason for the present tense international relations is the inadequacy of the Russian foreign policy, the policy necessitated essentially by the criminal nature of its present oligarchical regime. Such a regime cannot, in principle, have an adequate strategy for partnership relation with the West, which is necessary for the normal functioning of the whole civilization. Instead of partnership cooperation, the Kremlin sees international relations simply as non-interference and therefore as a rivalry with the West, which antagonizes both sides and naturally leads to an infinite arms race, to a new world war. Thus the present Russian regime presents an existential threat to civilization and cannot be tolerated any longer.

The above suggests that the true purpose of any reasonable strategy towards Russia is to overthrow its current dangerous regime and to replace it by democracy. The present Western strategy, however, is aimed usually at making Russia accept the Western way of life, which is wrong and could only exacerbate the crisis. The reason is that Russia has endemically an Eastern mentality and cannot be converted to the Western one. Moreover, Russia is the Eastern geopolitical pole which seems to be destined for a partner cooperation with the Western geopolitical pole – the USA. Besides, the overthrowing of any oligarchical regime can scientifically be brought about only by the revolution of its own people, not by some foreign force.

As to the revolution in Russia, it is currently impossible because, under the repressive regime, the people cannot be properly inspired, educated, organized and equipped for it. Therefore, without the proper change of the current Russian regime, the confrontation between Russia and the West will continue infinitely threatening civilization increasingly with a new world war. Fortunately, the current situations in Ukraine and Belarus seem to suggest some hope in this regard: for example, a successful democratic revolution in Ukraine could ignite democratic revolutions both in Belarus and Russia, thus solving the crisis in question.

It follows that the relations between the West and Ukraine should be thoroughly changed: instead of making attempts at tearing Ukraine away from Russia and antagonizing them, the West should start supporting, as much as possible, those true patriotic Ukrainian people, as well as those pro-Russian and left opposition circles in Ukraine, who would like to start struggling for the true self-governance, true socialism, the only type of society that could ensure the just and prosperous future for the Ukrainian people; the society that, by the way, was promised by the president Zelensky in his presidential campaign.

Thus the road map for the true strategy towards Russia looks as follows:

- (1) to start an overwhelming propaganda of the ideology of self-governance, the true socialism;
- (2) to start realizing the above ideology via the network of local, municipal and regional soviets;
- (3) to organize protection and self-defence of the soviets;
- (4) to make Russian the second state language in Ukraine;
- (5) to start replacing the existing administration by self-governance up to the federal level;
- (6) to organize the life of the country in the regime of self-governance and propagate its success;
- (7) to apply the above strategy towards Belarus and Russia already prepared for the revolution.
