Players Information sheet



Registration – Lounge area, Clubhouse

- **One person** from your team should go to the registration desk to register the team and collect a score card.
- The team member is responsible for entering the players handicaps (full and 90% allowance) on the cards.
- There will be a starter at the 1st tee to confirm further competition, course information etc. Please be ready to tee off at your allocated time.

Clubhouse Access – Through the main entrance or via the ladies locker room

- The clubhouse will be open for refreshments all day but numbers will be restricted. Tables will be set in 4's and players must sit no more than 4 to a table.
- There is a one way system operating –all visitors using the lounge prior to play must sign in with the bar staff (for track and trace purposes).
- When there is no clubhouse seating available due to numbers we ask for understanding.
- Competitors from a locally restricted area may only be seated outside.

Pro's Shop

- The Pro-Shop will be open and operating in line with PGA guidelines.
- There is a one-way system in operation and direction of travel is clearly marked. Only 2 people are allowed in at any one time.
- Cold drinks and snacks are available for purchase.
- Card payment is preferred for transactions.
- **NOTE: Face masks must be worn in the Pro Shop.**

Competition Format

- The Competition is a Team Stableford played from the red tees, 90% handicap allowance, max handicap 36.
- 2 scores to count at each hole.
- It is the team's responsibility to ensure that **all** the correct information is on the card.

On the Course

- There are on course toilets available which are located by the 11th green.
- There will be no refreshments available on the course.
- There is a slight course layout change. Players will go from 11 to 14 (follow signage), play 14, 15, 16, 12, 13, 17 and 18. Please remember to mark your scores in the correct place on the card.
- **Please Observe Social Distancing at all times**, particularly on tees and greens.
- Ball washers are sealed and out of use.
- Bunker rakes have been removed; players are therefore required to make their very best efforts to smooth the sand using their club and/or their feet. Players may use preferred lies in the bunkers and place the ball within 6 inches of where the ball lies, no nearer the hole.
- Flagsticks are to remain in the hole at all times and must not be touched.
- "Rings" have been fitted to the bottom of the flagstick allowing you to retrieve your ball safely and easily.

End of Round

- Scorecards should be signed by the **team marker only**, the marker's signature will be accepted as confirmation of the scores recorded
- Please also print the **team marker's** name in block capitals alongside the signature
- The team are responsible for scorecard completion and accuracy
- Inaccurately completed scorecards will result in a DQ

After Play – Result and Prizes

- **Only** the **team marker** should report back to the Competition Desk with the scorecard. This will be located at the end of the lounge
- The Competition Desk will record the relevant scores. The scores will be displayed on the leader board
- Markers should then place the scorecard in the box provided as directed.
- Cards will be verified and results published week commencing Monday 21 September
- Prize vouchers will be sent to the contact name on the entry form

Clubhouse Access After Play

- If you make use of the clubhouse after play then please be mindful of others who also wish to do so and leave as soon as you have finished your refreshments. Seating will be in groups of 4 maximum
