Subject: War Planning Arrangements Concerning the USSR.

1. The Strategic Plans Section (Op-30) is charged with:
- (a) Planning for and coordination of implementation of the naval aspects of strategic cover and deception;
  - (b) Acting as advisor concerning the enemy's capabilities for the employment of cover and deception against the United States.

2. It is requested that a situation study for USSR be made for Op-30 by 1 May 1947, in order to assist in accomplishing the objectives given in paragraph 1 above. It is considered that such a study should be reviewed periodically or when new information makes this advisable.

3. The situation study should include:

- (a) Structure of the Russian intelligence organization, to include that outside of headquarters;
- (b) Detailed personality studies of the USSR highest command and intelligence echelons;
- (c) Russian organization for and personalities connected with cover and deception;
- (d) Russian development of technical and operational methods for deception.
