

El Paso, Canada, Seaside Join 'Flying Disc' Zones

SEASIDE, Ore., June 28-(AP)—The latest report on the "flying saucers" came today from a Seaside woman who said she saw one of them winging soundlessly south at 5:35 P. M.

She was Mrs. Sidney B. Smith, wife of a Seaside policeman, who with her eight-year-old daughter Joanne said she watched the "round" object for nearly three minutes.

City Speeds Street Paving

Salem's summer street paving program is progressing rapidly with the South 12th street project's curbing expected to be completely installed this week, according to the city engineer's office Saturday.

Widening of the three-block strip from Mission to Bellevue is expected to be finished within a month, the office said. Similar operations will then begin to widen High street from Chemeketa to Ferry street.

Last week a curb-laying crew finished installing curbs on Jefferson street from North Commercial to North 5th street. This week the crew will begin work on Waller street between 14th and 19th streets.

About 5,000 feet of new curbing has been installed on city streets the past month, the office estimated. Paving the streets with concrete and black-top will follow grading. It is hoped by the office that the entire outlined paving program can be completed this summer.

A-BOMB STORES LARGE

TORNADO IN VIRGINIA

HOPEWELL, Va., June 28-(AP)—A flash windstorm of tornado-like velocity cut a path six blocks wide through a residential section of Hopewell this afternoon, damaged at least 100 houses and injured 10 persons.

Clyde Homan, operator of a tulip farm and writer of special newspaper articles, said he and his foreman saw two batches of the flat objects undulating through the sky near Woodland, Wash., yesterday.

VANCOUVER, June 28-(CP)—The "flying saucers," which have the experts puzzled and many citizens bewildered in the states of Oregon and Washington, have invaded Canada.

Two Vancouver citizens reported Saturday that they had seen the saucer-like objects flying over the city at great speed.

EL PASO, Tex., June 28-(AP)—Three El Pasoans today told of seeing flying discs in the skies during the last few days.

Additional reports of elements falling from the skies circulated in the Salem area Saturday, as an aftermath of the story told by a Boise pilot last Thursday regarding "discs" hurtling around the earth at 1250 miles an hour.

Mrs. Gertrude Kirkpatrick of 1780 Oxford in southeast Salem told The Statesman that on Tuesday night, June 17, she heard a "wooding" noise about 11 p. m. and that outside her living room window, apparently but a few feet away, three flashes of streaked-red light, at intervals of a few seconds, radiated from an area about the size of a plate. She had attributed the incident to camera flash-bulbs, until she read of the discs. She found no traces of any mysterious object on her lawn.

William A. Bond, 1165 N. 5th st., Salem, reported that on Wednesday afternoon, just after he had watched a plane toss out objects which looked like leaflets, he saw a "disc-shaped object much higher and coming from the northwest travelling southeast" at a speed comparable with an airplane. A similar bright object followed the same route about five seconds later.
