

CONFIDENTIALSTRATEGIC INTELLIGENCE SCHOOL

1. The Strategic Intelligence School is designed to provide training in the theory and practical application of strategic intelligence. It is divided into two six-week periods. During the first of these, lecturers survey strategic areas and discuss the substantive components of strategic intelligence. The speakers are highly qualified, experienced men, some whom also lecture at the National War College and the other high-level Defense Schools. During the second period students undertake strategic research problems. This assignment concerns either the country of the student's choice, or some phase of strategic intelligence. The course is comprehensive, intended to stimulate intelligence officers by providing them with a widened background in the problems of top-level intelligence. Candidates with limited intelligence experience profit most from the primary information presented, while those with more background benefit from a broadened viewpoint.
