

Gen. Ramey Now Heads Reactivated 8th Air Force

FT. WORTH, Jan. 10. (A)—Brig. Gen. Roger M. Ramey has assumed duties of commander of the recently reactivated 8th air force replacing Maj. Gen. Clements Mc-Mullen, who has been assigned to Washington as deputy commander to Gen. George C. Kenney, chief of the strategic air force.

A native of Denton, Tex., and a 1928 graduate of West Point, Gen. Ramey came to Ft. Worth as commander of the 58th (B-29) bombardment wing. He commanded air forces for the atom bomb task at Bikini.

Gen. Ramey, who is the holder of several decorations, is well known in Honolulu, where he served in prewar years when his rank was that of captain.
