Rep Frederick Frazier Impersonates a Woman?

Trying to locate the owner to get them to come remove it or tear down or whatever, anyway (214) 549-4918, (214) 549-4918, thanks." (See recorded voicemail for complete details).
- 2.3 On 02/09/2022, at approximately 3:28 PM, the manager of TeaLatte Bar, John Nguyen, sent a text message to (214) 549-4918 (Frazier).
- 2.4 "Hi I'm John with TeaLatte Bar. I will get the sign taken care of. Thank you."
- 2.5 Frazier replied- "TY, I'm telling everyone to toss them in the trash."
- 2.6 John asked- "What is your name so I can forward to land lord"?
- **2.7** Frazier replied- "Kerry Simpson." (See screen shot of text messages).
- 2.8 On 02/10/2022, I met with Kerry Simpson, who is the code enforcement officer with the City of McKinney. Simpson shared a series of text messages she received from Frazier asking if he could talk with her and informing her of Paul Chabot political signs that he felt were in violation. Simpson informed Frazier in a written email that his and Chabot signs were in violation at the Stacey and East Bond location. On 02-09-2022, Frazier sent Simpson a picture of a Chabot sign (Lake Forest-Walmart) that he felt was almost in the road. (See

Kerry Simpson is the Director of Code Enforcement for the City of McKinney. She's also a woman.



Rep Frazier's excuse was that it was a miscommunication due to voice to text.

5.22 Frazier stated after reviewing the texts with counsel, he put his head down on the desk and said that's not what his intention was, his intention was, and he did it with voice text to talk with Kerry Simpson. Frazier stated there's no ill will to being Kerry Simpson, that's not the intention of that text message. I asked Frazier during any of the incidents, did he represent himself as code enforcement at any time. Frazier stated, "No sir." Frazier stated he was getting calls consistently on what to do about these signs. That's been a consistent battle. Counsel asked for clarity as the candidate and not the city council. 


Catholic Charities Assisting Migrants?
