On June 11, 2015, the London Daily Mail wrongly reported that the “*statute of limitations*” for John Perry’s child sex abuse crimes had expired. On June 12, 2019, child sex abuse whistleblower, Austin Davis, requested a correction and provided truthful information to the London Daily Mail about protected child-molester John Perry, the 18-day jailing, and MBA Headmaster Brad Gioia.
