

Gospel of Matthew – Meeting 2

(1) How Are You (30 minutes)

1. Before sharing always open with an opening prayer.
2. Have each person share:
 1. The status of last week's requests **and efforts to share their testimony and Gospel of John.**
 2. What they are thankful for
 3. What they are concerned about (want prayer for) including contacts with non-Christians.
3. Pray in one accord or for person on their right.

(2) Loving Accountability (10 minutes)

1. How many STARS did you send this week?
2. What contacts did you have with non-Christians?
3. Who did you share your testimony or a CD messages or Gospel of John with this week?

(3) Vision Casting: Make Multiplying Disciples (5 minutes)

1. Read Mark 6:12. What did Jesus command his disciples to do? Are we to do it?
2. Read Acts 8:4. Who is it talking about? What did they do? Are we to do that?

(4) Follow Jesus (45 minutes)

1. Discuss 3 of each person's dos that they are working on.
2. If there is time, discuss the Stars.

(5) Fishing and Fishing Tools (25 minutes)

1. Have everyone practice sharing their “Personal Testimony Worksheet”
2. Refine your testimony and share it with someone this week.
3. The goal is to start listening to messages on our own. Show everyone how they can use podcasts on their smartphone or computer. Or, get a new messagee from www.a-teams.net.
4. Share 2 minutes of what you want to do from the message you heard last week.

(6) Goals (5 minutes)

1. Pick a day and time that everyone can meet.

2. Fill in the dates in the reading plan until the next meeting. Try to have the Review/Do day on the day of next meeting.
3. Meet with Jesus every day by studying the daily passage with STAR Bible Study method.
4. Pray for the people on the “Fishing List” everyday and ask God who to add to the list.
5. Listen to the new message twice.
6. Refine your testimony and share it with someone this week.
7. Look at Long-Term Goals

(7) Long-Term Goals (discussed as part of Loving Accountability)

1. Witness to at least one person a month. Therefore:
 1. Develop multiple non-Christian friendships.
 2. Learn to share with people you meet in the course of the day
2. Start discussing the Gospel of John with a non-Christian.
3. Start an A-Team with Christian (s).
