In today's Top Federal Headlines, the Justice Department's Office of Inspector General found three senior officials with the U.S. Marshals Service targeted employees who were cooperating with another IG investigation.

- The Justice Department inspector general found three bosses retaliated against underlings cooperating with an investigation, by the inspector general. One of the retaliators is the now-retired Marshals chief deputy. The IG found they pressed employees for information, restricted work assignments, and made threats.
