I write to follow up on our recent communications with you, Firm and Class Agents (CA's) responding to your April 13, 2022, letter (attached). Your dates mentioned are in concert with matters that CA's have discussed with a consensus majority that align with our contemporaneous notes, as well.

Again, using your words, "*we are family and may have differences*" and, in this matter, they are significant. Myself and other CA's also view the Firm's actions as having spread misinformation among class members, divisive and present false versions of our overall USMS (racial 'Black' discrimination) civil rights concerns for 28 years, incorporated in this Firm's rush-to-settlement. You have disregarded the interests and directives of CA's, demonstrating your inability to take conversations surrounding both monetary & programmatic relief genuinely involving decades of unprecedented and historic law enforcement civil rights violations. Facts that you have presented interpreting our discussions are absolutely, in dispute.

CA's & CM's disagree with your letters and direction without CM's having clear understanding or approval and are seriously concerned about your conflict of interest to continue as Class Attorneys. I too have corrected your mischaracterizations point-by-point in prior letters and agree with you that continuing this back-and-forth, although necessary to express our differences that henceforth, this form of communication is no longer productive.
