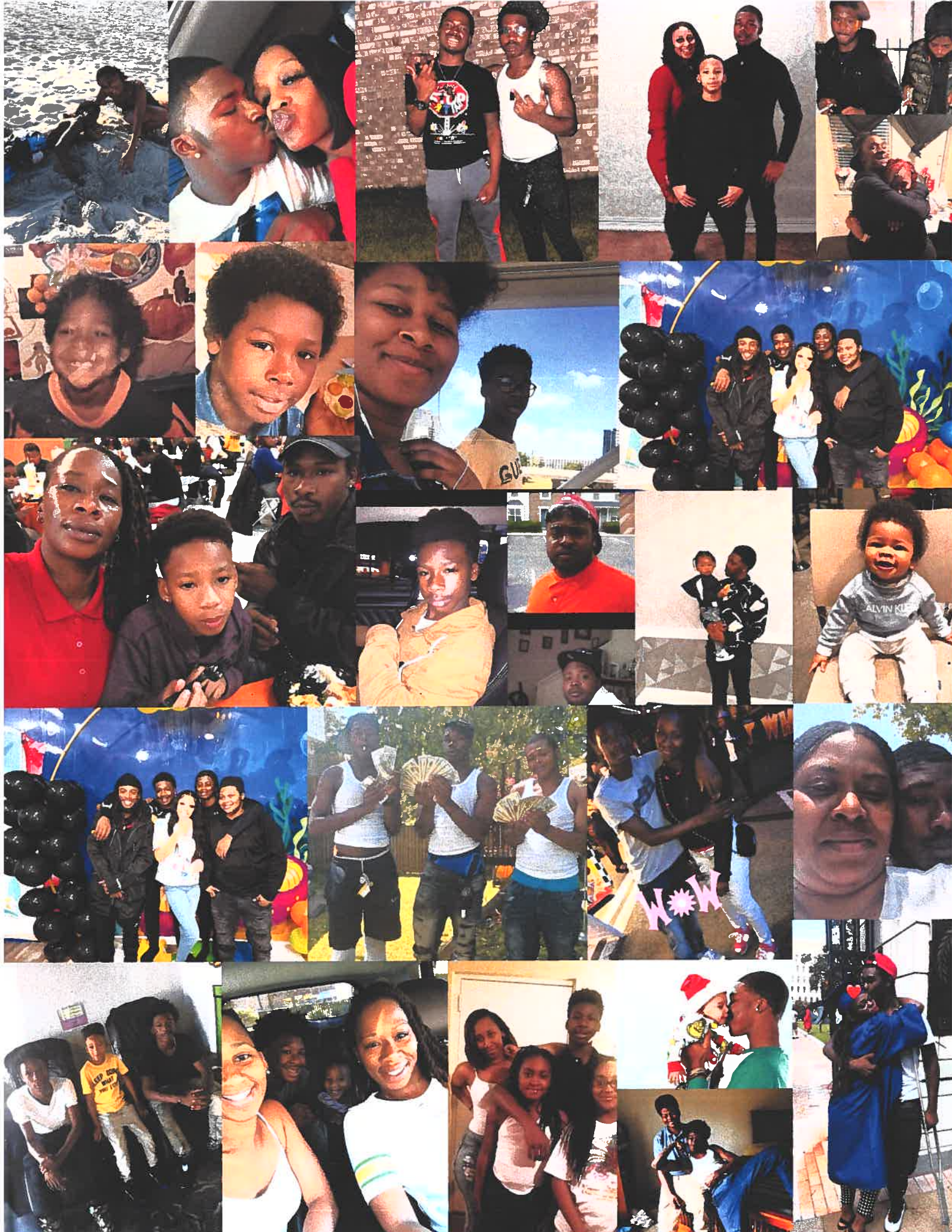
Dear Juggy,

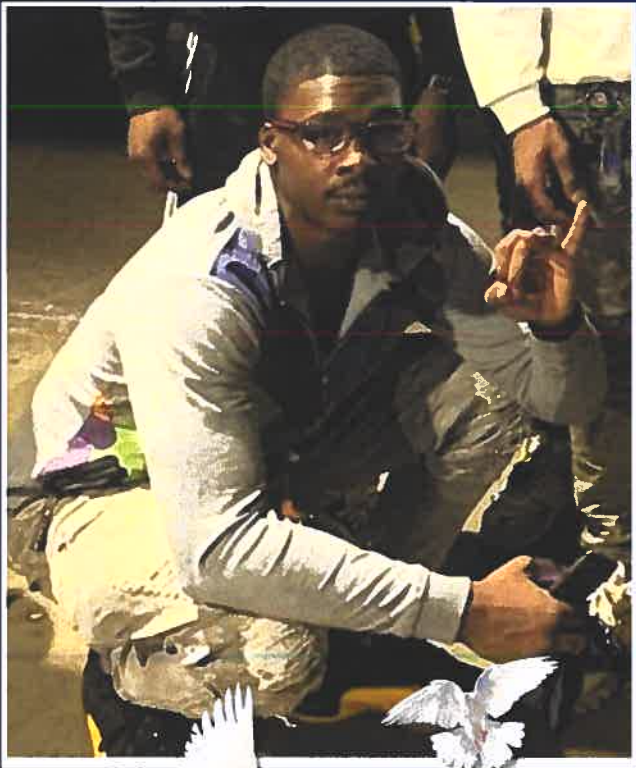
