

6 Wild Sharks Slot Demo: Number of Reels, Max Win & Features



The people behind 4ThePlayer are a fascinating lot. Even though they don't currently have a large library of games, the ones they do have are very diverse. 4ThePlayer has their hands in all kinds of sticky pies, from the snowy 9k Yeti to the crypto crash game 1,000x Busta (which, regrettably, we didn't find interesting enough to cover). Speaking of sticky, the 6 Wild Sharks Slot Demo has a ton of locked wilds or sticky wilds as they are known locally.

The 6-reel, 4,096 win-way game area is situated offshore in the middle of a vast animated ocean, drawing inspiration from Jaws rather than Sharknado. A touch of drama is added to the proceedings by the Jaws-inspired soundtrack. The visuals are a little sparse overall, but for the job at hand, they are more than enough.

Selecting the game's Classic or Advanced mode is the first step. While Advanced Mode gives players alternatives, Classic actually has nothing exceptional to offer.

The Wild Zones are located on reels 1, 2, 5, and 6. Up to 6 Locked Wilds can be added here, and they stay in place throughout every spin. The first two reels are more expensive, and the cost rises overall as you add more Locked Wilds.

To increase stakes by x8, for instance, cover the first reel with locked wilds. Or the price increases by 32x if there are 6 locked wilds on the first two reels. If you bet the maximum, that comes out to €1,600 per spin. The payable describes it as follows: add wilds on reels 1 or 2 for frequent wins, and add wilds on reels 5 or 6 for significant wins. You have complete freedom to choose.

Any device can be used to play 6 Wild Sharks in Classic Mode for 10 cents to £/€50 each spin. Depending on your taste for viewing, you can play the game on a mobile device in either tiny reels or big reels in portrait format. RTP in Classic Mode is 96.5%, and hits happen roughly every 3.8 spins.

RTP in 6 Wild Sharks Slot Demo increases to a staggering 97% level in Advanced Mode, but the exact Locked Wild configuration has an impact on the hit rate. Depending on your settings, volatility will change, although it is often pretty high.

Generic 10-A royals worth 1.2 to 2 times the bet are mixed in with the involved symbols. You can find fish, stingrays, octopi, a scuba diver, and a surfer girl in premiums, which are more theme-based. For a line of six, the premium values range from 2.5 to 30 times the stake. The shark wild, which can replace all other symbols in this article other than the buoy scatter, only appears in the Wild Zones (reels 1, 2, 5, 6).

The main game and bonus game are both impacted by the choice of Classic Mode or Advanced Mode. Free spins are awarded in both modes when scatter symbols appear simultaneously on reels 3 and 4.

You can exchange free spins for up to six locked wilds while playing in Classic Mode. You begin the feature with 15 free spins if you choose not to use any locked wilds. Using all 6 locked wilds results in just 1 free spin, which is the other extreme. For instance, the bonus game begins with 6 free spins if the first reel is completely covered in locked wilds.

You receive 10 free spins and any locked wilds that are already in place if you initiate the bonus game in Advanced Mode. When two scatter symbols land on the center of two reels in either mode, the feature can be reactivated, giving players an unlimited number of additional 3 free spins. Last but not least, for the duration of the free spins, any new shark wild that lands turn into a Locked Wild. 6 Wild Sharks Slot Demo: Verdict

ThePlayer mainly lives up to their name in 6 Wild Sharks. Players have a tremendous amount of control over how the game plays out in both the normal game and the bonus.

Even though these reel manipulation options sometimes come across as overly gimmicky, adding Locked Wilds can be helpful in 6 Wild Sharks. Overextending yourself and ramming all six on the first two reels is simple to do. While the hit rate is higher, raising the stake by 32 times is expensive.

Alternatively, you might choose the less expensive strategy of placing all six on the final two reels as a last-ditch effort. Alternatively, try mixing it up and placing some on the front and others on the back. Experimenting is half the fun. You can determine the strategy that best suits your thrill level and betting threshold by demoing the 6 Wild Sharks Slot Demo.

Advanced Mode is not available in all countries, including the UK, and Classic Mode is not as innovative. In actuality, the gameplay is rather banal, and just waiting for the bonus game to start. It is not nearly as exciting because there are no modifiers. But during free spins, things get better.

To make the magic happen in either mode, the wild zones must be completely filled with Locked Wilds. Once you do that, you can potentially win 10,368 times your initial wager.

6 Wild Sharks Slot Demo is a true game of two halves, to sum up. Unless you have a passion for the sea, Classic Mode is a bit of a write-off, but Advanced Mode includes some very intriguing features. As already indicated, the easiest way to get a sense of the game is to demo it and try out various crazy setups.

The focus of the 6 Wild Sharks Slot Demo is on player preference and player-friendly stats, which is novel in and of itself because it gives you the
