Odin Infinity Reels Megaways Slot Demo: Features, RTP & Volatility



The third installment of the Australian developer ReelPlay's Infinity Reels Series is called Odin Infinity Reels Megaways Slot Demo. Their most recent addition carries on a tradition started by their earlier works, all of which included a fantastical or historical component.

This time, gamers explore the fabled realm of Odin, the King of Asgard. You might be thinking that's nothing brand-new. To theme a slot, the Old Norse Gods are frequently brought out. However, ReelPlay's choice to mix the renowned Megaways engine with their own internally created Infinity Reels stands out.

There was some doubt surrounding the idea for a while. ReelPlay and NetEnt initially fought over who came up with the idea for Infinity/InfiniReels first. Like on a playground fight, curious people crowded around to see the altercation.

However, there was no pushing or shoving and no bloody noses. The handshake and parting of the ways signaled an amicable resolution to the dispute.

For the Odin Infinity Reels Megaways Slot Demo players, especially those on the harder end of the range, that is good news. It comes up frequently, but when making mythology-themed slots, you either go for cartoon-style graphics with everyone grinning broadly, or you do what ReelPlay did with Odin. There are no smiles to be found here. Since the tone is serious, it fits with the mathematical model of the game.

One distinction between this slot and the earlier Infinity Reel slots is that this one's volatility rating is Very High. We shall discuss how potential has also increased. RTP, though, is lower than the other two but is still respectable due to a rating of 96.18%.

The creator of Odin Infinity Reels Megaways Slot Demo, ReelPlay has therefore improved nearly every facet of the game while winding the math model up tight like a spring. Of course, the addition of the Megaways game engine is responsible for some of the makeover. As evidence, consider the frequently cited figure of 117,649 win ways. Megaways are accustomed to generating significant amounts of data.


Theoretically, Odin Infinity Reels Megaways Slot Demo makes that number seem paltry. Technically, the number of Megaways that can be activated is unlimited because there is no restriction on the number of reels that may be added. Alternatively, Odin is the first slot machine in the world to give Megaways to infinity, according to ReelPlay.

It's a catchy statement, but how does it actually apply? It's still necessary to land three identical symbols on consecutive reels to win; this happens, on average, once every 3.56 spins. Since there are only three reels in the game at first, winning symbols must appear on each one.

The Infinity Reels mechanism comes into effect when a combo occurs, adding a new reel for a chance to keep the wins coming. If more winning symbols appear, further reels are added indefinitely until no more winners show up. The game also features a symbol multiplier that starts at x1 and increases by +1 with each additional reel.

The best-looking game ReelPlay has ever created, Odin Infinity Reels Megaways Slot Demo is playable on all smartphones from 30p to £/€12 per spin. It's pretty amazing how much better this release is than their last one, Giza Infinity Reels. The creators have left no detail to chance in this magnificent work of art, which is situated in a surreal alpine valley and closely resembles a great oil painting.

The design of the symbols, which total 10 (regular) in the paytable and include 6 runes in addition to wolves, ravens, and an eight-legged horse, has also received a lot of attention. Odin is the highest symbol, paying out 8 times the value of one coin when three appear on a payline. Any other symbol besides the scatter can be replaced by the wild Valknut symbol.

Along with the Infinity Reels igniting the action, there is also a jackpot and a bunch of free spins to be won. In addition to any other winnings that occur during a spin, anytime 12 or more more reels are added, players are awarded a jackpot of 888 times their original wager. Although it might seem simple, statistically, this only happens about once every 63,323 rotations.

Gungnir, Odin's spear, should be kept an eye out because it activates free spins with any win. Players are shown two wheels prior to the start of free spins, which occur 1 out of every 315 spins. The first wheel chooses the number of free spins—either 8, 10, or 12—while the second chooses the win multiplier increment level. Every time a new reel is added in level 1, 2, 3, or 4, the win multiplier increases by 1, 2, 3, or 4 respectively.

Players now profit from the win multiplier not resetting between spins during the feature, which can increase to a high level if you get to play with an incremental win multiplier of 4. Players can extend the feature to receive an additional 4 spins whenever a Gungnir symbol win occurs. For a similar gaming experience, try out <u>Bigger Bash Bonanza slot</u>.

Odin Infinity Reels Megaways Slot Demo: Verdict

Reels of Odin Infinity With all this talk of Infinite Reels and Megaways, does it live up to its promises? Generally speaking, yes. Due to the enhanced graphics and significantly better reel-spinning animations, it is unquestionably a more sophisticated slot than the previous two, but aside from that, the inclusion of Megaways does feel a little gimmicky. Simply put, it doesn't add much that wasn't there before.

When there were four symbols on each reel, the reels might stretch indefinitely. Now, each reel may include a different symbol, but the difference isn't as obvious as it frequently is in a Megaways relaunch. Although the two mechanics complement one another well, the gameplay in Odin is not radically different from that of earlier games.

The concerning part is that after reviewing three Infinity Reels slots, the thought is starting to creep in that perhaps the Infinity Reels mechanic doesn't have much more to offer. It's much less dynamic than Megaways, and occasionally it even seems to be getting in the way of the Megaways engine's ability to function.

The changes below the surface are important in addition to that. In comparison to the first two, Odin Infinity Reels Megaways Slot Demo is far more volatile, and its potential is significantly greater than that of the other two.

The maximum wins now top out at 20,000 times the wager when the 12-reel jackpot is taken into account. Players get a taste of how Odin's eye for knowledge could feel when attempting to activate free spins. While waiting for big wins or features to appear, it can be difficult going and even a little monotonous.

Odin Infinity Reels Megaways Slot Demo franchise seems to be developing, in the end. Odin has improved in terms of appearance, the subject is excellent, and the potential is enormous. It is great for patient players or more seasoned gamblers because the game can be severe and repetitious.
