Dear Mr. Delapp:

Enclosed is a descriptive flyer about the actions planned at the Concord Naval Weapons Station by the Pledge of Resistance for the 12th and 13th of June. The staff of the Pledge should be contacted for more direct information regarding this (655-1177) but please feel free to call me again if the need arises.

I understand that several efforts are being taken to reduce possible traffic problems including: the Pledge office encouraging use of BART and the BART bus which runs from BART to Pittsburg via Port Chicago Highway; and local Pledge people who will be providing cars to shuttle participants to and from Concord BART. Additionally, the residents of Clyde have contributed their ideas and concerns to the Pledge for maintaining the free flow of traffic to and from their community.

Since the Mt. Diablo Peace Center is especially desirous of maintaining the excellent relationship we have with the Concord Police, we have voiced our concerns that traffic problems be minimized, and are pleased that the Pledge is responsive to our concern and is undertaking major efforts towards this goal.

I assume that you will be sharing this information with other law enforcement agencies such as the County Sheriff who might also be involved.

I hope this information provides you with the answers to many of your questions concerning the events of June 12 and 13. I do think it important to understand that the Peace Center itself is not the sponsor and/or organizer of these events.
