For another view of the parts left out of the Iran-Contra hearings, check out *The Iran Contra Connection* by Jonathan Marshall (editorial page editor of the OAKLAND TRIBUNE), Peter Dale Scott, and Jane Hunter (South End Press, \$11).

With 50 pages of footnotes from sources like the WASHINGTON POST and THE NEW YORK TIMES, the book takes original research and previously unconnected facts that are part of the public record and makes them a comprehensible and scary whole.

One part of the book points out that the biggest wholesale drug dealers in Florida are anti-Castro Cubans who use skills and connections they acquired while working for the CIA. By supporting the contras, the US government may well be training the next generation of big time drug dealers.

The Iran Contra Connection is less emotional than a speech by Daniel Sheehan, somewhat less bizarre in what it reports, and might be more persuasive to a neutral reader because it has lots of footnotes from establishment sources.
