

Proposal for greater effect at the weapons station

When Nuremberg Action was organized it was anticipated that when we prevented trains or trucks from proceeding normally, there would be arrests and court trials.

However, the response of the police at first was to dislodge protestors violently without arrest. When this produced poor public relations they resorted to the 849 harassing procedure which entailed three or more days in jail. Finally, under threat from our attorneys, they now allow citation release but hold protestors for periods up to twelve or more hours in a TV-dominated, overcrowded holding cell, without allowing us our day in court.

By continuing to restrict our activity to blockading only those vehicles carrying explosives, we are making it possible for the weapons station to avoid any major interruption of their operations. The police are informed when there is a train or explosive truck involved and only when we notify the base that we intend to block are police called in. We are a problem for the police but have very little effect on the base.

I propose that from now on we notify the base that it is our intention to block all traffic at as many gates as possible, depending on the availability of people.

We will have a greater effect on base operations when we adopt this plan. If you agree with me please let me know as soon as possible.
