The second or middle clue will actually take you to a real geocache treasure

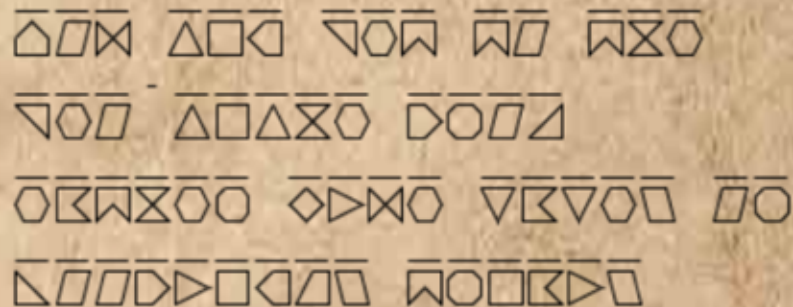
There's a ponderous puzzler Donahue
