Y. Manager's Report.

City Manager Paul Anderson provided the following verbal updates:

Engineering Updates

- Jakes is working on the Memorial Building overflow parking lot. They are coordinating with Luppino for paving this and multiple other projects for this fall season.
- The \$598,000 TMF grant is now awarded to Jakes. Some of that work will be done this fall and the remainder of the 500+ services will be done next summer.
- \$11MIL Phase 1 of the water plant project continues with CD Smith Construction. They are continuing to work on underground piping work, as well as interior and exterior masonry, and roofing work. We are working on numerous change orders to spend our remaining contingency funds.

- \$11MIL Phase 2 of the water plant: we are working on getting the contract documents all in line and then will be moving some work from Phase 2 to Phase 1. Work to begin in the coming months.
- The \$3MIL lead service line replacement project continues with Jakes Excavating. They are solely working on restoration work the last couple of weeks. We have spent around \$1MIL and aim to spend the remainder of the funds by the end of 2025.
- Phase 5A water system project started a few weeks ago. Lake Ave the water pipe and services are in and they are waiting to start concrete work once Xcel completes their gas line work at the end of September. Albany Street water piping work is in process.
- Phase 5B water and sewer project the design has begun will continue through the winter. The bid will occur in winter of early 2025 and construction will occur in 2025 and 2026. This is roughly a \$11 MIL construction project. We will be setting up a work session before the next meeting to go over costs of sidewalks and street paving that need to come out of the City budget, separate from the Grant.
- Curry Park Campground: We are waiting on the DNR bid spec review so that we can bid out some site furniture improvements this fall for the DNR grant project. The electrical project is in for permitting with plan for fall construction after closing. Then DPW will do some gravel pad improvements and restoration after all of that is done.
- Library Community Spaces Grant Project: The architect Meyer Group is meeting with staff to go over final plan changes and will be ready to go out to bid soon. Environmental work will be starting this fall. The project is planned for construction in 2025.
- The concrete plant at the old Ironwood Readimix site is now operating.

Managers Updates

- Fall cleanup day is this week. Sept 13th (8-2) and 14th (8-11) will be fall cleanup day at IPSD.
- HKGI is working on the Comp plan and the housing plan. There will be a series of stakeholder meetings October 1-3. We have regular meetings between our staff and theirs to keep up to date on where things are at.
- The November election is coming soon. The Clerk's office has 430 people on the absentee voter ballot list with more being added daily. Ballots are expected to be delivered the last week of September. Any residents with voting related questions are encouraged to contact the Clerk's office. The City of IW and 4 other local entities have received a \$5000 NGO grant to help offset election costs. Our grant will be used to help offset costs to repair our ADA access doors that have long needed repair.
- Iron Belle Trail fundraiser raffle is occurring this weekend. The \$100 raffle tickets give you a chance to win 8 prizes that range from \$500 up to \$3000. The proceeds go towards maintenance of the IBT. The drawing will be held on Sunday 9/15 at 1 PM which is the start of the Gogebic Range Ride and Run event which will be a bike or run on the Iron Belle Trail. If you haven't gotten your ticket yet, the last few are being sold this week in the Clerk's office.

Z. Other Matters.

Commissioner Semo commented on the Iron Belle Trail fundraiser raffle and encouraged residents to support the trail fundraiser.

Commissioner Mildren shared about the Gogebic Range Ride and Run (GRRR) event and shared comments he received at his class reunion about how wonderful of a community Ironwood is to live in.

As of August 31, 2024, we are approximately 17% through our current fiscal year. The revenues and expenditures of all major funds are in-line with this benchmark.

Cash and Investment Summary Report

The Cash and Investment Summary report shows the activity for the month of August, sorted by fund. Notable items are as follows:

- Cash-Checking account balances increased in the following accounts due to property tax revenue received (due date for summer taxes was August 10th); General Fund, TIFA, DIDA, Library Fund, 2015 Street Bond Debt Service Fund, Civic Center, and Public Safety Pension Fund.
- 2. <u>General Fund Investments MI CLASS:</u> Transferred \$500,000 from operating account into investment account due to higher interest rates.
- 3. <u>Water Bond Redemption Account:</u> Account balance decreased due to annual principal and biannual interest payments on the 2023 bonds.
- 4. <u>Current Tax Collection Fund:</u> Account balance decreased due to the collection and disbursement of summer property taxes.



Phase 5A Water Project

Work Change Directive #3 Albany Street Sewer

The first segment of the Phase 5 project, designated as Phase 5A, is currently under construction by Jake's Excavating & Landscaping, LLC. They are currently working on water main and services on Albany Street. During this process, it has been discovered that the existing sanitary sewer main consists of clay tile pipes and is only 3 feet deep. These pipes are in poor condition, exhibiting significant deterioration and numerous cracks, which make them susceptible to collapse if disturbed.

Due to the shallow depth of the sewer main, the contractor has attempted to tunnel beneath it to install new water service lines for the homes on the southwest side of Albany Street. Despite being aware of the sewer main's condition and implementing necessary precautions, there have been multiple instances where the existing sanitary sewer has collapsed, necessitating patch repairs.

The contractor has communicated concerns to both City and CEC staff regarding the potential for further damage to the patched areas, or the possibility of additional collapses, due to the heavy equipment and compaction techniques required for the road reconstruction. This notification serves to inform all parties of the issue, clarifying that the contractor does not assume responsibility for any damage resulting from ongoing work.

The recommended course of action is to replace approximately 690 feet of the old sanitary sewer main on Albany Street between Hemlock Street and Norrie Street. This proactive solution leverages the current road construction, reducing the likelihood of emergency repairs in the future. The estimated cost for this replacement is detailed in Work Change Directive #3.

Should the City Administration and Commissioners approve Work Change Directive #3, the design and subsequent construction of the sanitary sewer replacement will commence promptly. A Change Order will be prepared once the installation of the sanitary sewer main is complete and final quantities are confirmed. The project team will collaborate with EGLE to maximize coverage under the DWSRF funding. However, the extent of funding eligibility may depend on the level of sewer collapse during road construction activities, and EGLE's participation in cost-sharing for this replacement is not guaranteed.

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



Reasons for Change Order #7

1. <u>Stainless Steel Bolts, Nuts, Hardware</u>: The Ironwood Water Treatment Plant has a pump chamber that is normally full of chlorinated drinking water. There is 12" and 16" ductile iron pipe in the pump chamber for the high service pump discharge, piping to the clearwell, and an overflow. The piping and associated nuts and bolts are normally submerged. There are approximately 300 submerged 7/8" or 1" nuts and bolts in the pump chamber.

The project specifications did not include a specific designation for "submerged" nuts and bolts. The default material designation for the nuts-and-bolts material is galvanized steel. The contractor issued an RFI to clarify whether the submerged nuts and bolts in the pump chamber should be stainless steel rather than galvanized steel. Stainless steel has better corrosion resistance properties than galvanized steel.

The project team reviewed the application of galvanized bolts in chlorinated water and found the following statement from the American Galvanizers Association: "The use of hot-dip galvanized steel immersed in pool water is not a typical application. Given the fluctuating water properties and high levels of chlorine, a high or variable corrosion rate can be expected. The coating may perform anywhere from a few months to a few years."

Given that galvanized steel nuts and bolts are not recommended in a submerged chlorinated water application, we recommend changing the nuts and bolts to stainless steel. The cost of the material change is \$19,814.38.

- 2. Gravel Surface Deduct Phase I Bid included gravel roads around the future clearwell. Since Phase II will be built immediately after Phase I, these roads will be destroyed by excavation of the new clearwell in Phase II. Therefore, the gravel surface is eliminated in Phase I and will be added in Phase II at a future date.
- Septic Control Panel Changes were needed to get a signal to SCADA system. Also, the Western Upper Peninsula Health Department code changed after bidding and added such items as Audio/visual alarm code and elapsed time meter on pumps,
- 4. Rack/Stand for A/C Unit Since the A/C unit needs to operate all year to keep instrumentation cool, the exterior A/C unit will be place on a stand to keep the unit above the snow levels in Ironwood, Michigan in the winter. No stand was originally specified.

 - a. Base coat heated to solidly fuse glass to pipe surface.
 - b. Subsequent coat(s) heated to form integral bond with preceding coat.
 - 2. Final finish parameters:
 - a. Thickness: 8-12 MILS.
 - b. Hardness: Above 5 on MOHS scale.
 - c. Density: 2.5-3.0 grams per cubic centimeter.
 - Metal to lining bonding: Capable of withstanding strain of 0.0001 IN/IN without damage to lining.
 - 3. Complete compatibility between fittings and piping.

2.5 LININGS AND COATINGS

A. Where specified in piping schedule, provide linings to a minimum thickness of 40 MILS.

2.6 SOURCE QUALITY CONTROL

- A. Factory Test:
 - 1. Subject pipe to hydrostatic test of not less than 500 PSI with the pipe under the full test pressure for at least 10 seconds.

PART 3 - EXECUTION

3.1 INSTALLATION

- A. Joining Method Push-On Mechanical (Gland-Type) Joints:
 - 1. Install in accordance with AWWA/ANSI C111/A21.11.
 - 2. Assemble mechanical joints carefully according to manufacturer's recommendations.
 - 3. If effective sealing is not obtained, disassemble, thoroughly clean, and reassemble the joint.

- 4. Do not overstress bolts.
- 5. Where piping utilizes mechanical joints with tie rods, align joint holes to permit installation of harness bolts.

B. Joining Method - Push-On Joints:

- 1. Install in accordance with AWWA/ANSI C151/A21.51.
- 2. Assemble push-on joints in accordance with manufacturer's directions.
- 3. Bevel and lubricate spigot end of pipe to facilitate assembly without damage to gasket.
 - a. Use lubricant that is non-toxic, does not support the growth of bacteria, has no deteriorating effects on the gasket material, and imparts no taste or odor to water in pipe.
- 4. Assure the gasket groove is thoroughly clean.
- 5. For cold weather installation, warm gasket prior to placement in bell.
- 6. Taper of bevel shall be approximately 30 DEG with centerline of pipe and approximately 1/4 IN back.

C. Joining Method - Flanged Joints:

- 1. Install in accordance with AWWA/ANSI C115/A21.15.
- Extend pipe completely through screwed-on flanged and machine flange face and pipe in single operation.
- 3. Make flange faces flat and perpendicular to pipe centerline.
- 4. When bolting flange joints, exercise extreme care to ensure that there is no restraint on opposite end of pipe or fitting which would prevent uniform gasket compression or would cause unnecessary stress, bending or torsional strains to be applied to cast flanges or flanged fittings.
- 5. Allow one flange free movement in any direction while bolts are being tightened.
- 6. Do not assemble adjoining flexible joints until flanged joints in piping system have been tightened.
- 7. Gradually tighten flange bolts uniformly to permit even gasket compression.

D. Joining Method - Mechanical Coupling Joint:

- 1. Arrange piping so that pipe ends are in full contact.
- 2. Groove and shoulder ends of piping in accordance with manufacturer's recommendations.
- 3. Provide coupling and grooving technique assuring a connection which passes pressure testing requirements.

E. Flange Adaptors 12 IN and Less:

- 1. Locate and drill holes for anchor studs after pipe is in place and bolted tight.
- 2. Drill holes not more than 1/8 IN larger than diameter of stud projection.

F. Cutting

- 1. Do not damage interior lining material during cutting.
- 2. Use abrasive wheel cutters or saws.
- 3. Make square cuts.
- 4. Bevel and free cut ends of sharp edges after cutting.
- G. Support exposed pipe in accordance with Section 40 05 00.
- H. Install buried piping in accordance with Section 40 05 00.
- I. Install restrained joint systems where specified in Section 40 05 00 under specific piping system.

3.2 FIELD QUALITY CONTROL

A. Test piping systems in accordance with Section 40 05 00.





Re: Budget Amendment for City Staff Restructuring

After more than 39 years of service and dedication to the City of Ironwood and its citizens, our current Clerk II-Treasurer will be retiring at the end of this year. With this change in personnel, we feel now is an opportune time for some administrative restructuring. The proposed plan includes the hiring of an additional employee and creating two new positions. The duties of the current Clerk II-Treasurer would be split between the two new positions. Each of the two new positions will take on additional duties and responsibilities.

The City currently does not have a Human Resources Manager. However, there is a great need for this position. Human resource managers are important to an organization's success because they help ensure that employees are used effectively, and that the employee life cycle is one of growth and fulfillment. Some of the responsibilities of the Human Resource Manager for the City will include:

- Performance management: Helps ensure that employees are performing in line with the City's strategies.
- Organizational culture: Helps shape the City culture so that employees are happy, well-performing, and satisfied.
- Recruitment: Helps identify and source the best candidates for the City
- Compensation and benefits: Helps keep employees motivated and rewarded based on their performance.
- Training and development: Helps ensure that employees are skilled enough to fulfill their responsibilities.
- Controlling payroll: Helps ensure that payroll is processed accurately and efficiently.
- Employee relations: Helps ensure that employees are happy and have fewer conflicts through open and clear communication.
- Onboarding new employees and retention: Helps ensure that new employees are successful immediately and long-term.





The other proposed new position is an Assistant Finance Director/Deputy Treasurer. This position will take on the duties of the current Clerk II-Treasurer, except for payroll. In addition, this position will take on additional responsibilities and duties including budget forecasting and analysis (including collective bargaining), general ledger maintenance and monitoring, procurement process monitoring, and more direct training under the Finance Director/Treasurer. The creation of this position will allow for a more seamless succession planning process for the Finance Department. It will also allow the Finance Director/Treasurer to focus more time and resources to other areas of need and opportunity, such as investments, budget oversight, long-term budgeting, inventory management, grant monitoring and reporting, improving communications with the citizens, businesses, vendors and funding agencies, reviewing/updating current finance policies, as well as developing written procedures for all finance related functions.

This restructuring will benefit the City of Ironwood organization, its employees, and the community we serve. It is recommended that the City Commission approve a budget amendment for this staffing change. We estimate the net cost for wages and fringe benefits to be an additional \$88,000 for the current fiscal year. This will impact the City's General Fund. As these are operational expenditures, the funding will come from operational revenues. Current projects budgeted to use operational revenues would now use unassigned fund balance. Our current interest income is outperforming our budget this fiscal year. If this continues, we may earn enough interest income to cover the cost of this net change for the current fiscal year.
