On 5/1/69, representatives of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) observed four unknown white males enter the Soviet Embassy, 1125 - 16th Street, N.W., Washington, D.C., at 9:43 PM and depart at 9:50 PM. They arrived and departed the area as passengers in a blue Ford which was driven by an unknown white male who did not leave the auto and was bearing 1969 Maryland License FL 6525.

Re WFO airtel to Bureau 6/24/69,

Re airtel advised that DONALD FLICKINGER was
most likely the operator of captioned vehicle. FLICKINGER
was previously noted, is well known to WFO for past,
intermittent business contacts with foreign diplomatic
establishments.

WFO advised the Bureau that efforts would be made to
interview FLICKINGER since this appeared to be the only possible
way to establish the identity of unsubs.

Repeated messages have been left at Courtesy
Inc., (FLICKINGER's secretarial service) since he is rarely
in WDC, for extended periods. Miss SHARON ASH (a former WFO
employee) of Courtesy, Inc., advised on 8/11/69, that she was
aware that FLICKINGER had received the messages, however, he
expressed the attitude that he was not interested in talking
to the FBI.

She further advised that a check of Courtesy, Inc., records indicated that FLICKINGER, had rented office space on the date of the visit for a business conference with clients from outside of WDC.

Since FLICKINGER is a consultant on technical matters and had met with business contacts the same day it appears that the visit to SOVEMB may have been business connected. Consequently there does not appear to be any compelling reason to interview him.
