Flemingsburg Landmark **Recieves Facelift**



The beautiful home of Bob and Billie Jones, located at 405 Mt. Carmel in Flemingsburg recently underwent a facelift with a new coat of green paint. This home known as the "Kenner House" commissioned Kentucky Landmark by the Kentucky Heritage Commission and was

featured in "Gardens to Gables Architecture and Landscape s from the Bluegrass and Beyond.

This beautiful home was described as follows, "Green shingles over the frame, 1.5 story Kenner-Plummer House, which dates to around the first decade of the 20th century. It captures one of my favorite periods of vernacular architecture when the whimsy of the Victorian period was fading but still exerted an influence e, and was combined with new styles like the Colonial Revival. A tiny row of dentils run like a belt. Purse above the paired windows in the gable of the facade, while above the dentils (or denticulation if you like!) is a small attic bent."

Refreshing this beautiful home with a fresh coat of crisp green pain was Jeff Moore and according to Mrs. Jones "he did a beautiful job"!


