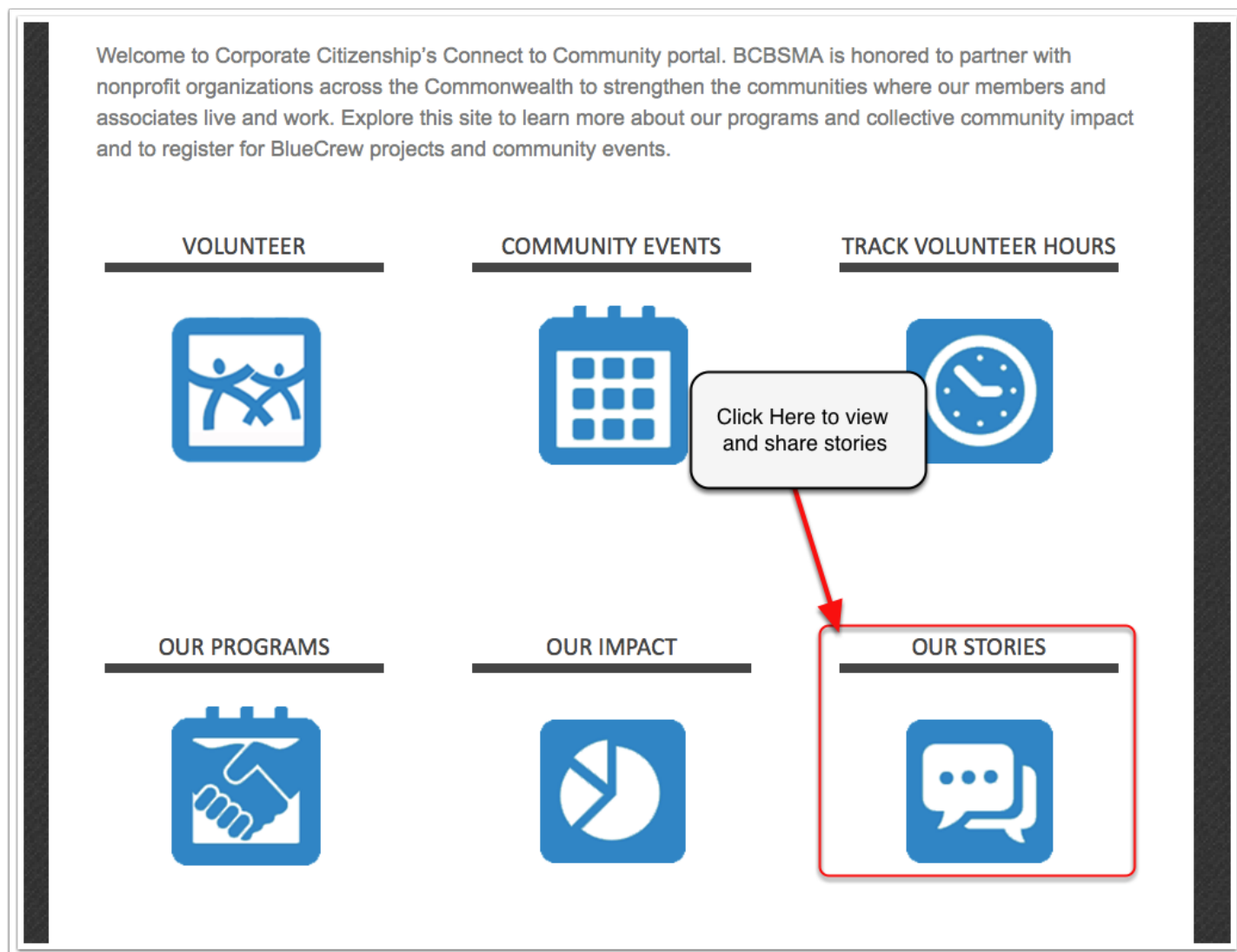


1. Dashboard
