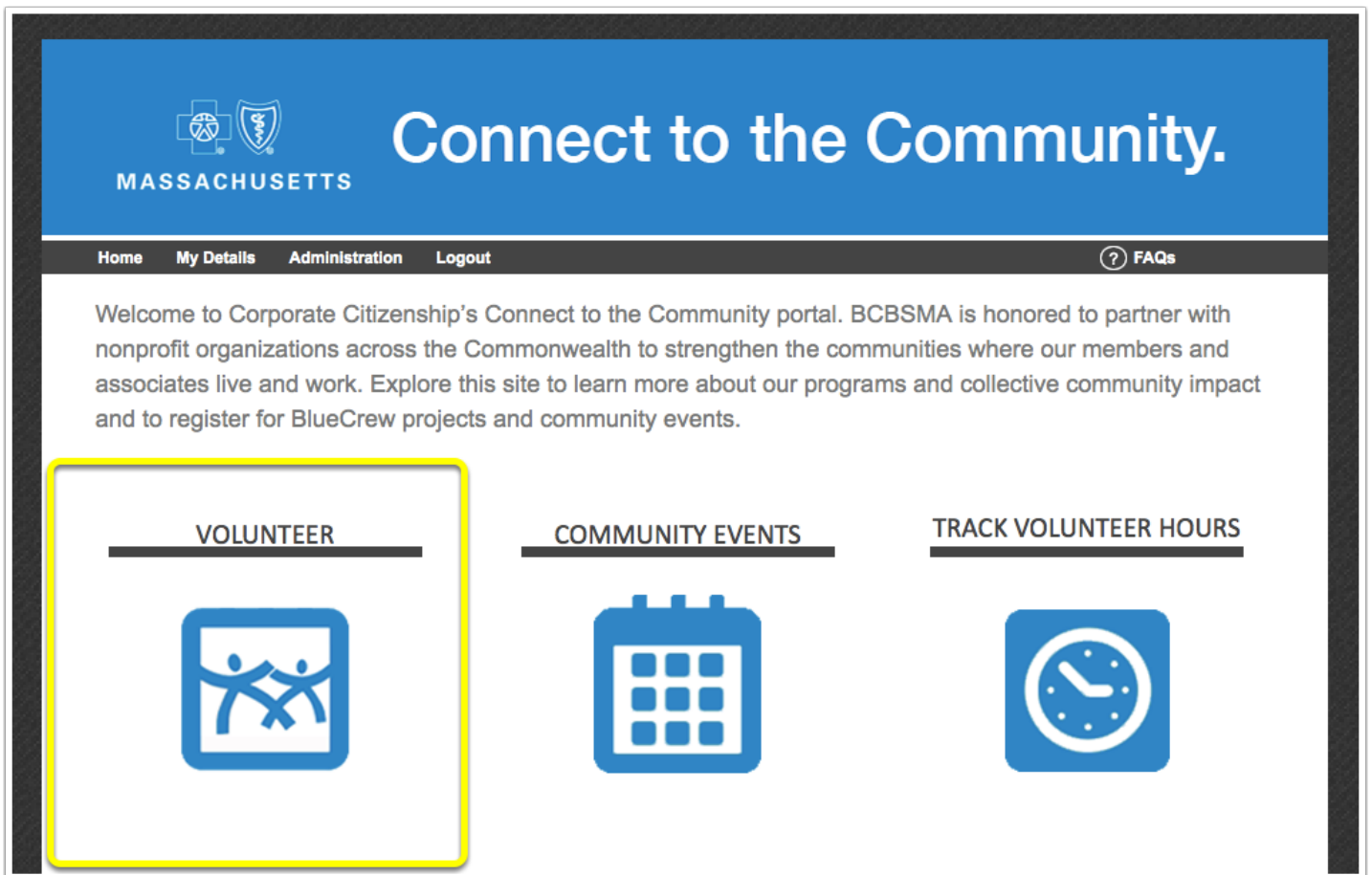


1. Click on "Volunteer"

Crossroads For Kids

Departing from 25 Technology Place, Hingham, MA to Duxbury, MA,

Project Description: Crossroads for Kids is an education enrichment program in Duxbury that provides city kids with the opportunity to experience outdoor recreational activities in a natural environment – an opportunity many of these young people do not have at home. When over 1000 youth come to camp each summer, they stay in cabins built over 75 years ago. To provide a more comfortable space for campers, volunteers will build new bunkbeds, paint the cabin roofs, clear trails and landscape the grounds. There is also a unique opportunity at Camp Wing to utilize bicycle maintenance skills if you have them! In addition, volunteers will prepare the site for its school year programming when Crossroads' kids engage in leadership skill building, college readiness workshops, financial literacy programs and community service projects. ...
