- How can pride in the contributions that all Americans have made—and continue to make—to our nation be shared?
- How can current and future members of ethnic and cultural groups learn more about one another through storytelling?
- How can ethnic and cultural group organizations provide benefits to keep their members engaged and maintain their support?

Our program and its outreach activities can help ethnic and cultural group organizations do all of this.

The history of our nation is deeply tied to diversity and immigration, whether forced or voluntary. Ancestors of most Americans today came here from another place. Legacy stories acknowledge that heritage and culture are rich aspects of personal and group identity. The accomplishments, life experiences and lessons learned recorded in these stories afford future generations knowledge, insight and inspiration. Using storytelling to communicate about ethnicity and culture broadens understanding, increases tolerance and heightens acceptance. It can also be a wonderful intergenerational bonding activity. Legacy stories also contribute to the telling of our nation's history and are a key element in a comprehensive social studies education.

Our 32-year-old nonprofit foundation encourages everybody to share their life stories on our Heritage Honor Roll and learn about the contributions that all people have made—and continue to make—to our nation. For a one-time, tax-deductible fee of only \$49, your members can join Americans All to create a legacy story and access our high-quality social studies resources. When your organization becomes a Legacy Partner, at no cost, the membership fee for your members is only \$24.50. As a Legacy Partner, your national organization and its affiliates can each create a home page on our Web site, in multiple languages if desired, to host stories of your members, their families and your staff.

Americans All invests more than half of its membership fees to strengthen social studies instruction to help ensure all students are prepared to participate in our nation's democracy, economy and workforce. We aim to give K–12 schools nationwide equal access to supplemental state- and grade-level-specific classroom resources that meet state standards in social studies. In addition, teachers can also access free professional development opportunities so they can learn how to use our and other resources most effectively. Member families can also access our social studies information.
