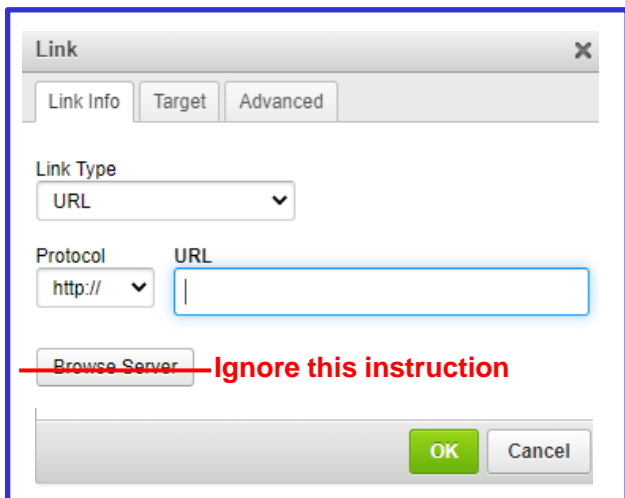
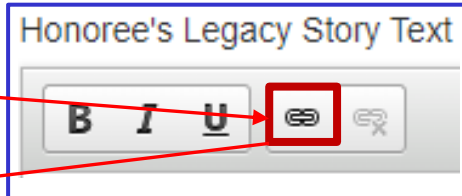
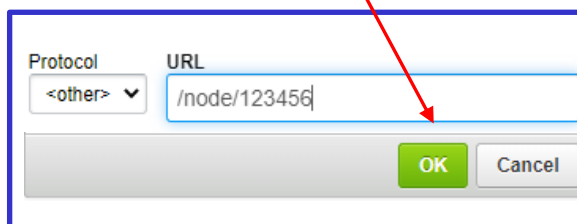


How to Create My Honoree's Story in an Additional Language

To hyperlink your story to another story on our website, create a link by adding a line of text—in the language of the other story—to the bottom of your story. Before you do this, you will need to know the 6-digit code of the other story. The line of text should say: “To view this story in (insert the language), click here”. Then use your cursor to highlight the words **Click here**, and click on the “chain icon” in the tool bar as shown. A new link box will open on the page.



Because both stories are housed in “Americans All.com,” insert `/node/6-digit number` in the URL box (the “Protocol” will automatically change to “<other>”) and click on **OK**.
